Room type	Single (40 sq m) room with Private ensuite
Maximum price for room	The maximum price that you can be charged for this room is a refundable deposit of \$900,000 or daily payments of \$200.96 or a combination of both.
Explanation of payment options	Residents can choose to pay for their accommodation by three separate methods. A Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD - lump sum), Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP- periodic payment) or a combination of both the RAD and DAP. Please note that there are a number of rooms available within this "room type" below the maximum RAD. Note prices are subject to change without notice.
Example of a combination payment for room	For this room a resident could pay, for example, 50% of the price by a refundable deposit of \$450,000 and 50% of the price by daily payments of \$100.48.
Room description	Victoria Grange offers 1 deluxe suite which is approximately double the size of the standard room offering. This room has direct access to a shared balcony with scenic views. This room has its own private well appointed sitting room with a stand-alone wall heater in addition to the reverse cycle air conditioning. This room is fitted with automatic door open and close functionality to facilitate access for mobility impaired residents as necessary. This room due to its size and separate living area creates a home like ambience.
