The well-stocked pantry is replenished each day with fresh produce and, if you need assistance with cooking, your care companion is there to help.

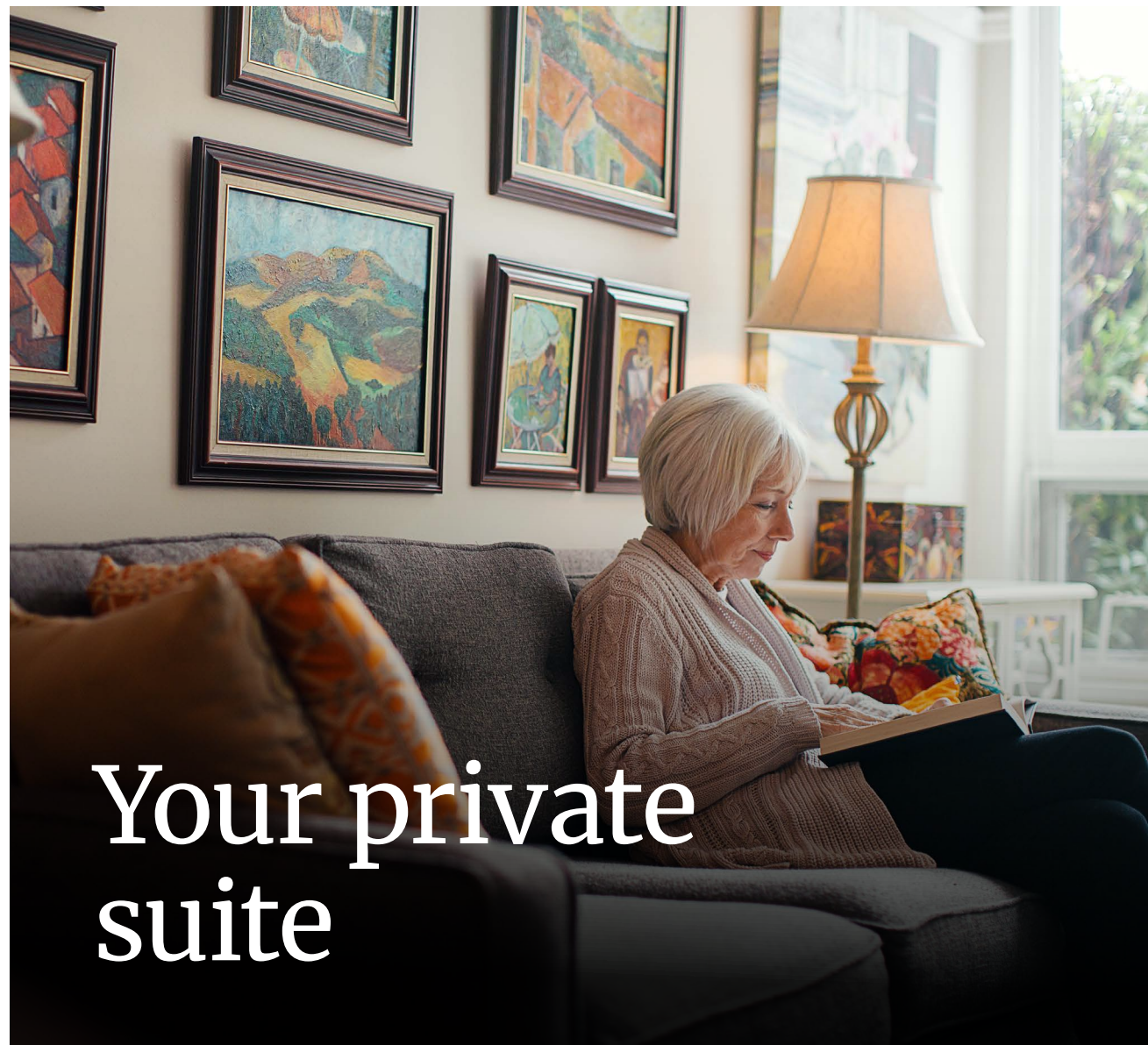
Join in the activities

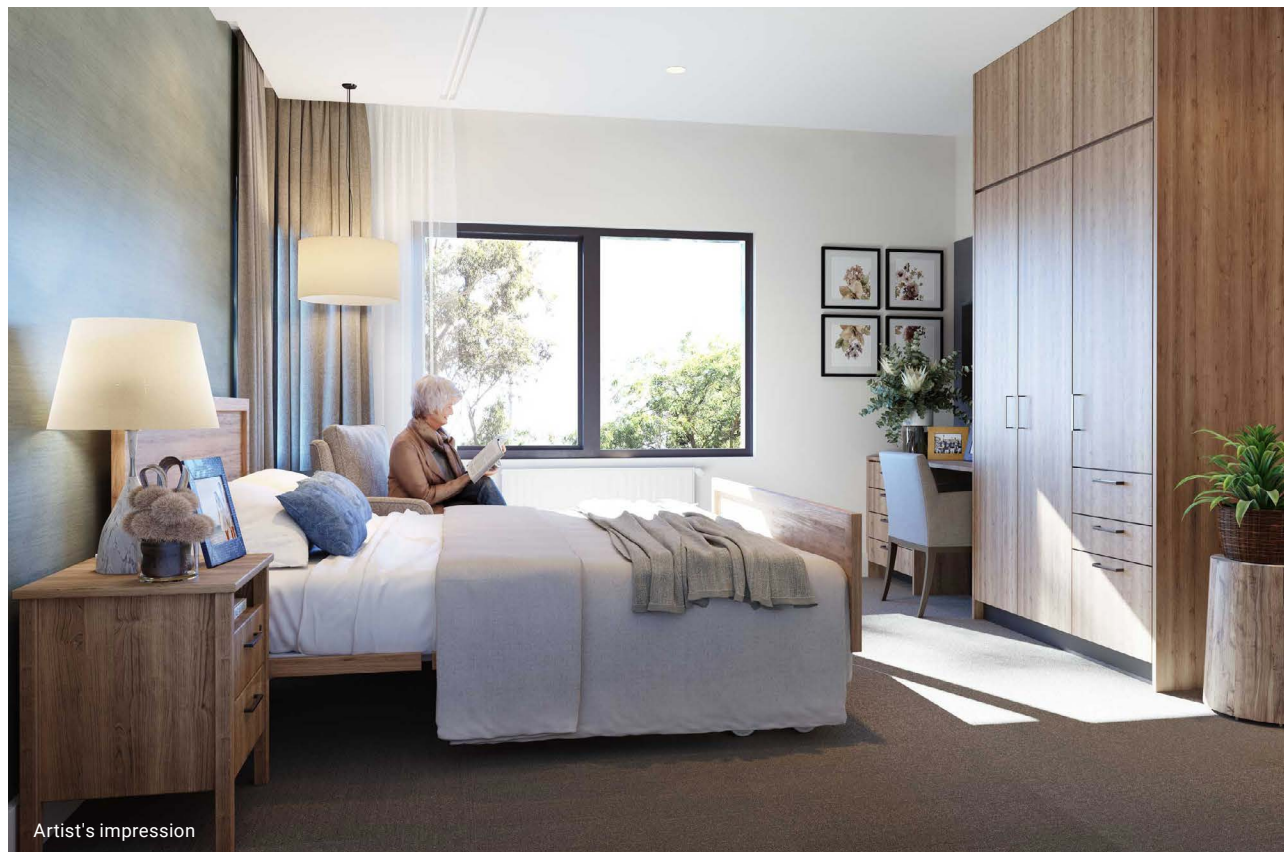
Our spacious premium suites, ranging in size from 30m² to 31m², offer the highest standard of accommodation and are perfect if you're looking for more space.

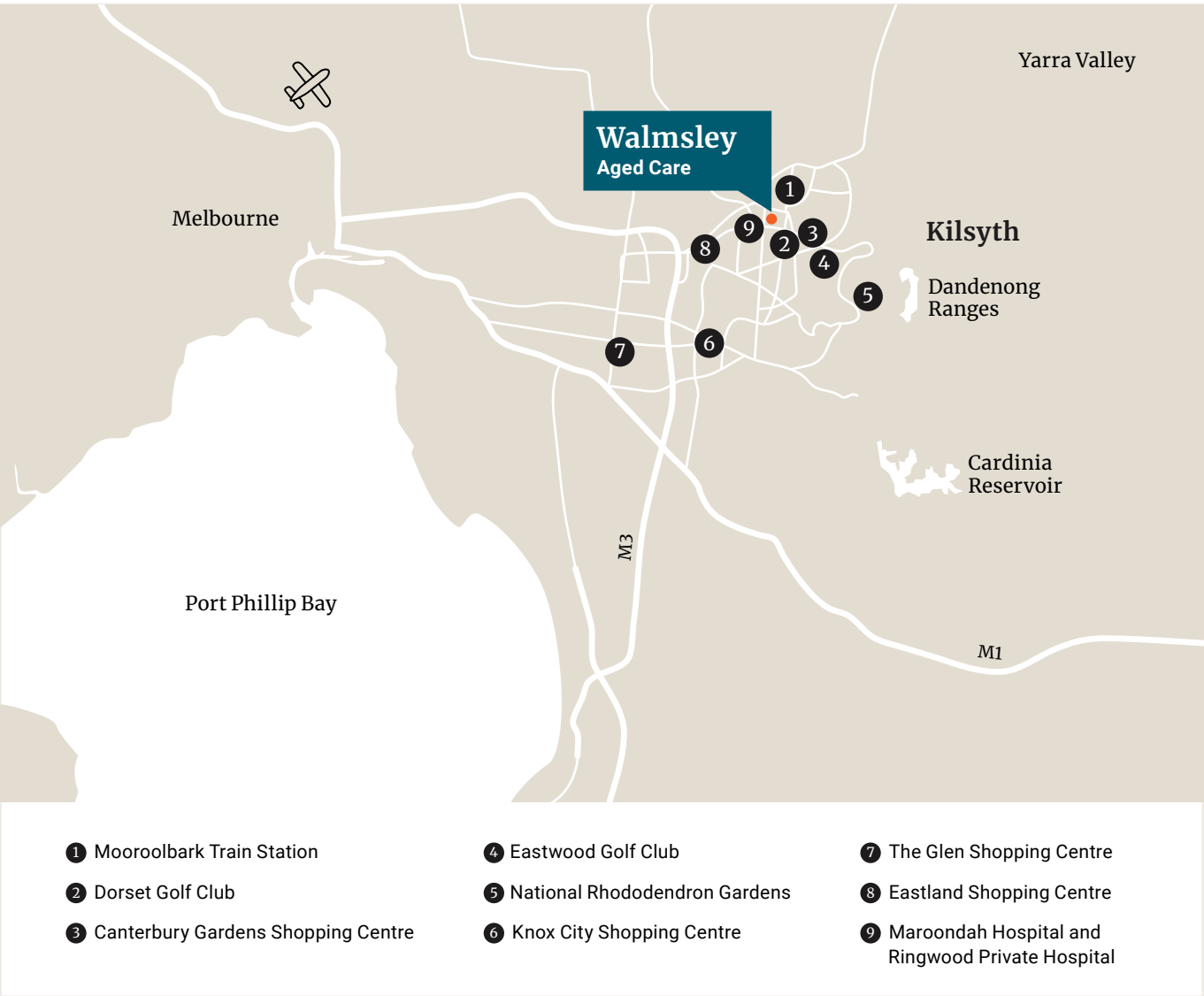

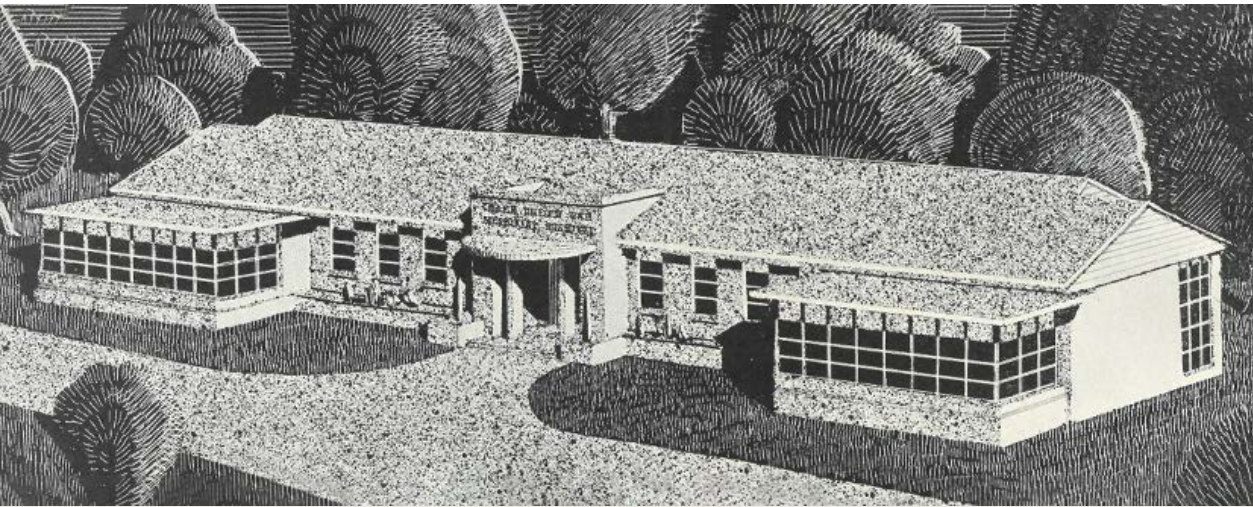
