Online survey

Australian Unity, in consultation with Metro North Hospital and Health Service, is finalising its masterplan for the redevelopment of Herston Quarter and would like to invite the community, staff, students and visitors to provide input into the ongoing masterplan design.

Your opinions will give us valuable insight into creating a master plan that reflects your needs, particularly about future services, public space and amenity.

This survey has 24 questions and should take approximately ten minutes to complete. You will also have the opportunity to register your interest to participate in a focus group.

Site Activity Update

2018 will see the transformation of the former Children's Hospital site into a hive of construction activity, generating hundreds of construction jobs.

Construction of the state-of-the-art specialist public health facility is on track to start in the coming months. In the meantime, bulk earthworks are continuing to prepare the site for construction.

During bulk earthworks we aim to recycle as much of the excavated materials as possible, using specialist computer software to determine both the amount of material to be removed and how much can be reused for future works.

Specialist public health facility

We are very pleased to announce that Economic Development Queensland has recently approved the Development Application for the specialist public health facility and new public space that will form part of the exciting transformation at Herston Quarter.

This public facility comprises eight levels of health facility including seven operating theatres, endoscopy rooms and recovery spaces, specialist consulting for a number of disciplines and inpatient accommodation. The new facility will also include basement and above ground parking levels at the rear of the facility.



The specialist public health facility will be linked physically with Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital via the skybridge and will contribute to the globally prestigious Herston Health Precinct.

The building is also supported by a strong public realm.

Community engagement

Following finalisation of the Development Scheme for Herston Quarter in December 2017, we are excited to work in partnership with Metro North Hospital and Health Service to actively engage with the community as we begin to finalise the master plan for the site.


