## Australian Unity Property Income Fund – ARSN 094 220 498

### February 2023 Property Valuation

The Fund's long term leasehold interest in the Edith Cavell Building in the Herston Quarter Health Precinct in Brisbane, Queensland was independently valued as at 28 February 2023.

The property's value increased by 4.50% on the prior year's external independent valuation of \$11 million, while recording a (\$0.29) million or (2.50%) decrease to the property's book value immediately prior to the valuation, which was predominantly due to capital expenditure. The capitalisation rate remained steady at 6.25%.
